Grow, Play, Learn: School Readiness. During this eight-week program, children, 4-5 years old, will learn basic knowledge for school through stories, songs, and games.

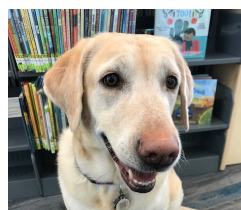
