Getting Started with Your Hotspot

Charging the Hotspot

- 1. When the Hotspot battery indicator shows a low battery, it is time to charge the Hotspot.
- 2. Plug the connector of the Hotspot power cable into the port on the front of the Hotspot. The Franklin T9 Hotspot uses a micro-USB cable, while the Franklin T10 Hotspot uses a USB-C cable.
- 3. Plug the Hotspot power cable into an electrical socket.
- 4. Confirm that the battery is charged by turning on the Hotspot and checking that the device's home screen shows a full battery.
- 5. The Hotspot is ready to be used.

Turning on the Hotspot

- 1. Hold down the power button for 3 seconds.
- 2. When the device is on you will see the home screen light up.

Connecting the Hotspot to a Laptop, Tablet, Phone, etc.

- 1. Turn on the Hotspot.
- 2. Click Settings on your laptop, tablet, phone, etc.
- 3. In Network Settings, select Wi-Fi.
- 4. A list of available networks will display. Select the Wi-Fi name of the Hotspot.
- 5. Note: Press the Power button on the Hotspot several times until the Hotspot name appears on the Hotspot LCD display.
- 6. Enter the password of the Hotspot.
- 7. Note: Press the Power button on the Hotspot again. The Hotspot password appears on the Hotspot LCD display.
